1. Open up the internet browser Google Chrome (or another preferred browser of your choice).



2. In the address bar type in cttransit.com and hit enter.



3. Once on the website, move your cursor over "Routes". A drop down will appear. Click on "Local Service".






4. On the new page, scroll down and when you see "Hartford" click on it.



5. On the next page, scroll down until you find bus route "69 Capitol Avenue" and click on it.



6. Scroll down until you see available schedules for bus route "69 Capitol Avenue". You may click on each schedule to see different bus times.



7. You can switch back and forth between schedules and the website by clicking on the tabs on the top of the page.
